## LOCAL RULES

- 1. OUT OF BONDS (Rule 27-1)
- a) Beyond any white stakes, fence, hedge or wall bordering the course.
- 2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)
- a) All lakes shall be treated as water hazard.
- b) Lateral water hazards defined by red stakes.
- c) Water hazards defined by yellow stakes.
- 3. BUNKERS
- a) Stones in Bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1)
- 4. WASTE BUNKERS
- a) Play ball as it lies. You may ground your club and remove loose impidements in the "waste bunker area" as the area is through the green.
- 5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR
- a) Includes all vehicle marks, newly turfed and seeded areas, unfinished course work and all areas marked G.U.R. (Rule 25)
- 6. FIXED SPRINGLER HEADS
- a) These are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under (Rule 24-2)
- 7. BUGGY PATHS
- a) All buggy paths are immovable obstuctions, relief can be taken under (Rule 24-2b)
- 8. DISTANCE MARKERS
- a) These distances are measured to the center of each green.
- 9. SPEED OF PLAY
- a) Please keep pace with the group in front.
- 10. PLEASE REPAIR ALL PITCH MARKS ON GREENS, SMOOTH SAND IN THE BURKERS AND REPLACE ANY DIVOTS.
- All measurements of the holes are taken from the back of the tee box to the centre of the green.
- Please check the individual sprinker heads for spesific distances to the centre of the green.
